**Absentee Ballot Application for May 20, 2025 Election**

Under Education Law SEC. 2018-a and 2018-b

A completed application must be received by the Election Clerk no earlier than thirty (30) days (4/20/25) before the election, and no later than seven (7) days (5/13/25) before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter, The ballot itself must be returned to the Election Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on Election Day.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION

A. All applicants for an absentee ballot shall fill out, in full, the absentee ballot application and sign and date it.

B. The Election Clerk must receive all absentee ballot applications no earlier than thirty (30) days (4/20/25) before the election and no later than seven (7) days (5/13/25) before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be delivered personally by the voter. All absentee ballot applications will be accepted by the Election Clerk at the District Office, located at 234 Lincoln St., Gloversville NY 12078.

C. Upon receipt of an absentee ballot application, the District Clerk will review the application to determine if the applicant is a qualified voter and is otherwise entitled to vote by absentee ballot. Applications that do not specify the reasons why a voter will be unable to vote in person on the day of the election will not be accepted.

D. If the application is proper in all respects, the District Clerk will then mail or personally issue an absentee ballot to the voter.

E. All absentee ballot applications must be received by the Clerk at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be **mailed** to the voter, or the day before the election if the ballot is to be **delivered personally** to the voter.
